#### **Introduction**

From the Census of Ireland for 1901 and 1911 as published in The National Archives of Ireland website I will <u>summarise</u>, <u>but not analyse</u> the data under various headings for Bandon, in the District Electoral Divisions (DED) of Bandon Town, County Cork.

The data is from the National Archives of Ireland and from the said census I have shown in Table 1 the number of Females, Males and those where no data for sex has been recorded as N/R (No Record). We observe that the females outnumber the males in both census years.

#### Population in Each Street in Each Census year in the Town

Therefore we do not appear to get the actual total population of the town.



We note that there are significant variations in population in a few streets between the years, as example Castle Street has a population of 223 in 1901 and only 28 in 1911; Boyle Steeet has 94 in 1901 and 226 in 1911. Kilbrogan Hill, Devonshire Square and Barretts Hill being other notables.

Some streets were renamed in years post the census and the current names are shown below:

- Boyle Street = Connolly Street
- Castle Road = O'Mahony Avenue
- Castle Street = Pearse Street
- Cavendish Quay = Saint Patrick's Quay
- Cavendish Row = Emmet Row
- Higgin's Lane = Heading North off Watergate Street
- Hospital Lane = Heading NW from West end of South Main

- Sealy's Lane = Heading NW off Ballymodan Place
- Shannon Street = Oliver Plunkett Street
- Smith's Lane = off St. Patrick's Quay, a few houses to the SW of Harte's car park.
- Stanton's Lane = Saint Patrick's Hill
- Wesley Quay = St. Finbarr's Place

Let us look at the data for *Devonshire Square* and compare it for both years. The Census shows 16 persons in 1901 and 80 persons in 1911. In the following Tables we see the details of the people in Devonshire Square for both years.

Few names appear in both and those repeated are:

Frances Napier Curling. We observe she was aged 51 in 1901 and 52 in 1911

Henry George Johnston William W C Johnston John Eccles Johnston

Each of the Johnstons aged 10 years from 1901 to 1911 in the respective census returns. This is in stark contrast to Frances Napier Curling who aged just 1 year in that 10 year period.

Looking at the above Table we may conclude that there is no particular striking aspect of the data of just 18 records. Then looking at the returns for 1911 totalling 80 records we do not see any special category of people therein. An example of such a special category would be police or soldiers in a barracks, or a hospital.

Looking at the first name on the 1911 list below I wonder how many would remember hearing of Mr Alpers in Hilsers Jewellers in South Main Street?



Clearly those who we may today call students were the the dominant category and in the above Table we see they were recorded as Scholar (548), Scholars (30), Student (3), Scolar (3), Schoolar (3), Scholar Boy (3).
